Patient

- \$49 Direct-To-Consumer (Limited Insurance Accepted)
- 24 hour service, 365 days a year
- Patients in North Carolina only
- Ages 3 and up with exception of teens ages 13-17
- 20 Credentialed Providers: 18 Mid-Levels & 2 MD's
- Average Star Ratings:
 - > Care = **4.5/5**
 - \triangleright Providers = 4.8/5
